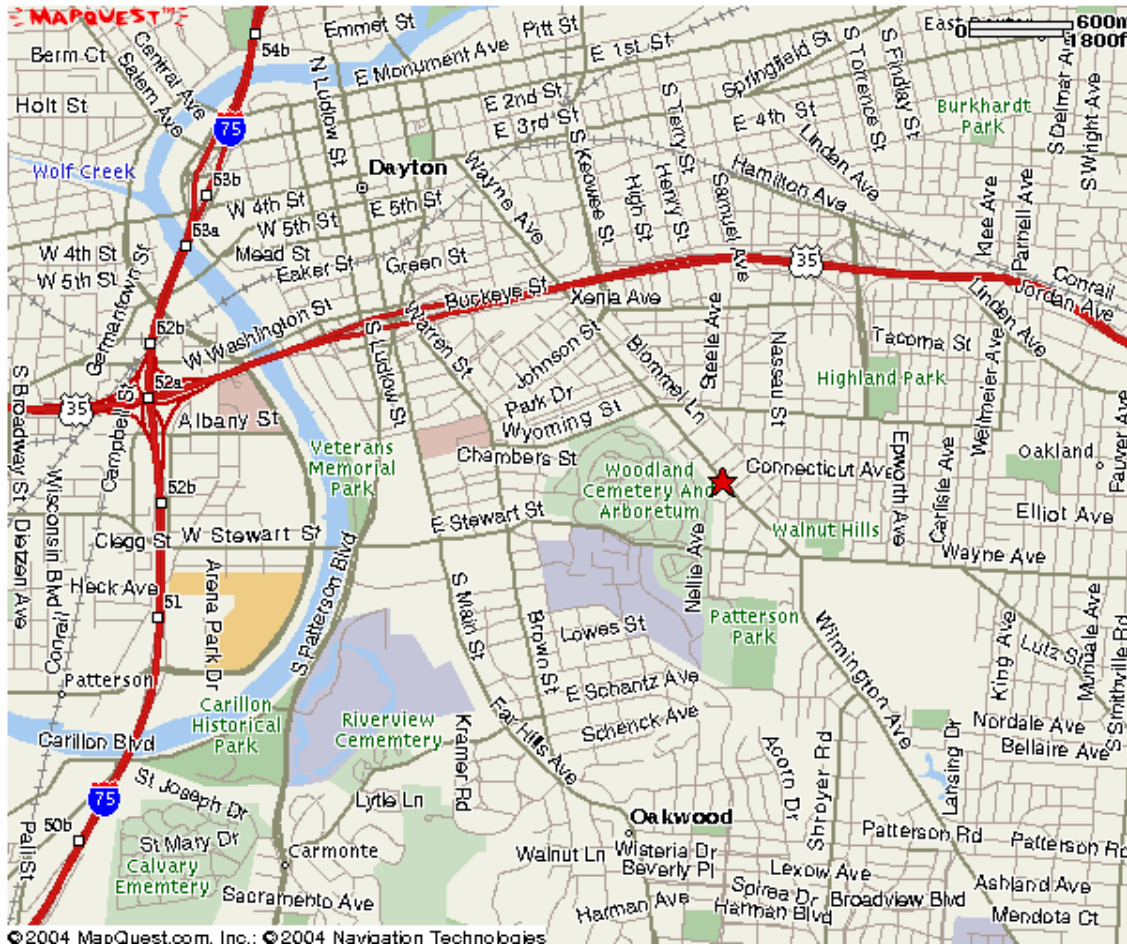
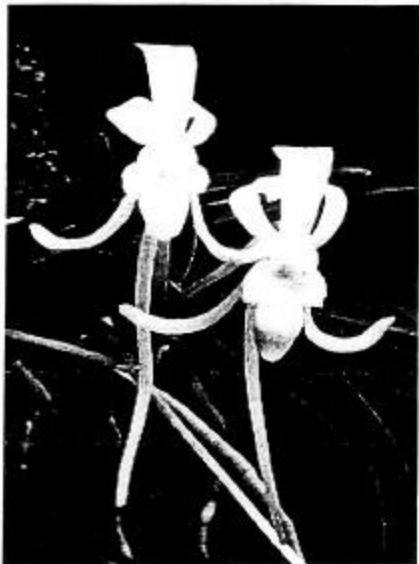


From I-75 exit 51 Edwin Moses Blvd to Stewart
