The meeting will be held at the Civic Garden Center on Reading Road across from Bethesda Hospital. The meeting is scheduled to start at 7:30 p.m. There will be time to socialize from 7:00 to 7:30.

Program

This month's program will be by Larry Sanford on "Miltoniopsis". Refreshments by Stan and Elaine Better and Lois Conyers. Each month we try to have a few nice plants at the meeting as raffle plants. The tickets are \$1.00 each, 6 for \$5.00. This month's plants are: Oncidium (Onc.) Twinkle "White", in bud – small plant, long spray of white flowers Vuylstekeara (Vuyl.) Terry Kennedy 'Cotton Candy' – medium-sized plant, tall spray of light to medium purple Odontoglossum (Larry-type) flowers. Epilaeliocattleya (Eplc.) Charlie Brown (=Lc. Rojo X Epidendrum cordigerum) – a medium-sized plant with cluster of 6 to 7 dark red flowers per stem. Phragmipedium (Phrag.) Sorcerer's Fire (=Sorcerer's Apprentice X Andean Fire) – flowers look very much like Noirmont but the plant is MUCH smaller!
