

## **Instructions for Plant and Exhibit Registration for MID AMERICA ORCHID CONGRESS –FALL 2008**

MAOC has a Special Class of unique judging criteria to increase the ribbon and trophy opportunities. Class 121 is for plants with the most pleasing fragrance and Class 122 is for plants with the most foul fragrance such as a few interesting bulbophyllums, etc.

The basic instructions for entry apply to both e-mail and “in-person” registration. For e-mail registration, information should be entered in the attached Microsoft Word form and e-mailed to the address below. Please use this form if possible. If this just doesn’t work for you, just include the required information in an e-mail to the address below (please use a separate line for each entry). Additions, corrections and/or deletions can be made during the at show registration.

The procedures are basically the same as usual. The difference is in the tag number which is discussed below.

Class – As usual, enter the appropriate plant or exhibit class from the provided show class schedule –under column -- class 1. If a plant is to be double entered, enter it again with the appropriate class # (113, 114, 121 or 122) under column -- class 2.

Tag # -- use this only If you are entering more than one of the same grex in the same display (same genus, species or intergeneric and name or unnamed cross) please enter a different letter for each of the duplicates (ie; A, B, C etc) in the appropriate class box after the Class number

Not for AOS Judging If a plant is not to be AOS judged place \* (an asterisk sign) in the class box after any needed class # (and letter).

Exhibitor – Please use the assigned exhibit number plus a unique letter for each individual. ie. - in exhibit 35, entries might be 35A, 35B, 35C etc. Please include a listing identifying what person goes with which number in your e-mail.

Plant Name--Enter the plant genus and name plus clonal and award if applicable.

Parents – Please list the genus and name of both parents for the entered plant

If you have more entries than the number of lines in the form, just add more lines or send multiple forms. When finished e-mail to: [GCOSinfo@zoomtown.com](mailto:GCOSinfo@zoomtown.com) from now until before 11:00 AM, Friday, September 5,2008 or if necessary, at show registration between 12:00 noon and 7:00 PM, Friday, September 5, 2008.

Please make a copy of your registration entries to follow up if there are any discrepancies or losses in the registration process
